## NW ARKANSAS MOUNTAIN BIKE CHAMPIONSHIPS DEVIL'S DEN STATE PARK SEPTEMBER 18TH AND 19TH, 2010



### PEDALHEADS!!!!

This year the park will celebrate 22 years of mountain biking. Like last year, Saturday will be reserved for the multi lap race (Area A) and the trials (pool area). Registration for the race will be Friday night and Saturday morning at the Visitor Information Center. The awards and SWAG GIVE-AWAY will be Saturday night at the café's pavilion along with ice cream and food for all participants including super D and trials. Sunday is for PTD super D Time Trials competitors (full-faced helmets required) which will use first 2 miles of the Butterfield Hiking Trail. All events are spectator friendly. And remember, this is a point series event for the Arkansas Mountain Bike Championship Series.

This race is USA Cycling sanctioned (Pending). USA Cycling rules will be followed. CAT 1 must have a USA Cycling license to compete and you must have your license at registration. Annual licenses will be sold at registration. CAT 2 and CAT 3 may race with a temporary license for an additional \$5. All participants must also hold an AMBCS license, which is \$5.

**AN AMBCS LICENSE IS REQUIRED FOR ALL RIDERS!! CAT 1 must ALSO have a USA Cycling license.**

### SATURDAY

**7:00am to 12:00noon Registration:** Same place as Friday night - Visitor Information Center audio visual Room.

### RACE TIMES AND INFORMATION

The races will begin in Campground A. The course will include Racer's Hill.

One lap is approximately 5.6 miles.

**9:00am: All CAT 3, Clydesdales and juniors, except junior expert.** CAT 3 women and juniors 12 and under will ride one lap. Remaining CAT 3's, Clydesdales, and 13 and above juniors will ride 2 laps.

**11:00am: All CAT 2 and single speed.** This group will ride 3 laps.

**1:00pm: All CAT 1 including juniors.** CAT 1 will ride 4 laps.

**1:30pm: BIKE LIMBO. Campground A:** "How low can you go?" For kids of all ages

**2:00pm to 3:00pm TRIALS REGISTRATION:** Meet in the Ridge Runner café pavilion.

**3:00pm to 6:00pm OBSERVED TRIALS:** Watch this thrilling event as skilled riders jump over man-made and natural objects. This event will take place next to the lake / cafe area. Participants need to be there 15-minutes early for a riders meeting.

**6:00pm to 8:00pm Awards for the race and trial competition Also swag and food!** All competitors, including Super "D" participants,, need to meet at the café pavilion for awards, swag and food. . After the trials, we are going to fire-up the outside charcoal grill to cook 200 hamburgers donated by **Tankersley Food Service**. For homemade ice cream, you need to bring a spoon and bowl; you have to crank to eat.



### SUNDAY



**7:00am to 9:00am SUPER D REGISTRATION:** Visitor Center's audio visual room

**10:00am to 2:00pm PTD SUPER D TIME TRIALS:** The course is 2 miles long with a 600-foot elevation change. There are several accents on the course that will require pedaling. It is "One and Done." You will not want to miss this event. We will use the Butterfield Hiking Trail for this event. The start will be where the BHT crosses Hwy 74. The finish line will be in the walk-in campground. **There will be a required riders meeting before the race. Full-face helmets** are required for the participants.

**The Super D course will be closed on Saturday until after the cross country competition. The PTD Super D will be open to register riders on Sunday morning.**
